Family Conversations

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

Worship Response - Praise the Lord!

When God rescued His people by bringing them through the Red Sea on dry ground, all the people praised Him! They put their trust in God, and then they worshiped Him for all He had done.

Spend some time worshiping God together as a family this week. Think through ways God has rescued you or shown His power in the life of your family. Invite the members of your family to share their thoughts, and then have a worship party!

Create It! Red Sea Treats

God did an amazing miracle when He parted the Red Sea and led His people through it on dry ground. He rescued them from their slavery and brought them to freedom!

Spend some time talking about God's big story and what it means for God to rescue His people as you enjoy some Red Sea treats together.

Get some graham crackers and either buy or make blue icing. Ice the edges of the graham crackers, leaving a dry strip in the middle of the cracker, so it looks like dry ground in the middle of blue water. Then add a few gummy fish to the icing.

Or, make some blue gelatin dessert in a 9" x 13" pan. Once it's firmed up, cut a strip out of the middle and crumble some graham cracker crumbs into the empty strip to make ground. Add some gummy fish or sprinkles to the "water."
