Family Conversations

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

What are two words that describe how you feel about Jesus being alive? • *Mary Magdalene ran to tell Peter and John the good news about Jesus being alive. Tell about a time you got such good news you couldn't wait to tell someone. What was the news?* • *Name three really important moments in history. How do they compare with the moment Jesus rose from the dead?* • *Not only did Jesus rise from the dead, but He also promised if we follow Him we too will live with God forever. How does that shape how we plan for our futures?*



Walk It! Act It! Move It! - Hop to It!

Pull out that sidewalk chalk and get ready for fun!

Work together as a family to create the longest hopscotch game your neighborhood has ever seen, one that stretches along the sidewalk for a gazillion miles. Or maybe a little less—it's up to you.

Once you've got the hopscotch board ready, play the game as a family. (Not sure how to play? Look it up online.) Bonus points if you can get others to join in. Double bonus points if those others are adults!

As you enjoy life together and make some major memories, realize the life you're enjoying is one that Jesus gave you. And when you remember that Jesus died and rose again, you have a wonderful reason to enjoy that life!



Walk It! Act It! Move It! - Hide and Seek Surprise

Time for some hide and seek—with a twist! Pick one family member to be the "Seeker." That person will slowly count to 50 while everyone else finds the perfect hiding spot. But rather than simply hiding, "Hiders" will listen for the Seeker to get close and then they'll leap, crawl, or jump out of hiding to surprise the Seeker before the Seeker surprises the Hider.

No matter how surprised a Seeker is when Hiders pop out of corners and closets, the disciples were even more surprised when Jesus came out of His tomb. They discovered something that changed their lives: Jesus lives!
