### Life Connection: Dinner Discovery

For one week, every time you gather for dinner, ask this question: "Where did you see God today?" Keep a record of all the ways God revealed Himself to your family. At the end of the week, read the list together and thank God that He speaks to you in so many different ways.

### Family Conversations

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

*Have you ever felt like God has spoken to you? • What good plans do you think God has for our family? • How do we know God's plans for us are good plans? • Where have you seen God's love today?*

### Interactive Prayer: Praise for God's Good Plans

This week we are focusing on how God's good plans cannot be stopped. Use this fill-in-the-blank prayer with your child to help her remember God has good plans for her too. This activity might be familiar to your child if he attended church this past week, so be sure to ask what he learned during the lesson.

"God, thank You for the way You love me. This week I am learning that Your good plans cannot be stopped. I know Your plan for me includes \_\_\_\_\_. Help me to always remember You have good plans for me. In Jesus' name, Amen."
