Family Conversations

Life Connection: A Window

Perspective

As a family, look out a closed window at what's outside. Take turns naming what you notice—a bush, the sky, a shadow, that candy wrapper you dropped and forgot to pick up. See how long a list you can generate. Then, as a family, go outside and stand by the window. Add new things you notice such as smells and sounds. Now how long is your list?

If you truly want to know something—or someone—it's best to go to the source. When someone tells us about God, it's like looking through a window at Him. But when we get to know Jesus, we can experience God and know Him so much better!



Create It! - Recreate It! Photo Night

Go online and find some photos of families (hint: "Weird Family Photos" will pull up a few classics!) and then, as a family, see if you can recreate those photos using your phone or a camera. Compare your recreations with the originals. How did you do? Where do you see resemblances? What looks different?
